Parents Code of Conduct

- Do not force an unwilling child to participate in cricket.

- Encourage your child to play by the rules.
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Remember that children learn best by example.
- Appreciate good performances and skillful plays by all participants.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Encourage your child to attend training and club activities and where an issue exists to speak directly with Team coach or Team manager.

As a Club we are asking for all parents support in adopting the Clubs code of Conduct and at all times being mindful that actions contrary to this may impact our Clubs reputation and perception in the Local community.
