Players Code of Conduct

- Play by the rules of the game.
- Never argue with an umpire.
- If you disagree, have your captain, coach or Team manager approach the umpire during a break or after the game.
- Control your temper.
- Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours in cricket.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team mates. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all participants in cricket as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Cooperate with your coach, team mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please others and coaches.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability cultural background or religion.
- Attend training regularly so that your game and that of others can improve. Be a GOOD Club person and support the activities of the Club as best as you can.

As a Club we are asking for all players support in adopting the Clubs code of Conduct and at all times being mindful that actions contrary to this may impact our Clubs reputation and perception in the Local community. It is a requirement that each player sign & date this document.

Breaches of this Code will be dealt with by the Selection committee on the Tuesday Night following match completion and offending players will be required to attend. It shall be the responsibility of the Captain to notify the player.
