

OFFICIAL 2007/2008 SEASON REVIEW























Presidents Report

I'd like to thank the committee and the members of the Knox Gardens CC for the opportunity and honour of leading the club this year. In a Year that has had significant challenges I am proud of our efforts on many fronts.

The season started some 8 months ago with a new Senior Coach in place, a record number of Junior Teams, with Council approval for a grant to improve our Training set-up, with a major Council infrastructure project to improve our main ground and of course much hope regarding our potential for a Winning Season in many grades.

The off Season had seen much work and the new Season would require and enormous effort to be able to allow the club meet internal expectations while basically being housed in a temporary facility down at Llewellyn reserve. This single issue alone was always going to test our resolve as a committee and a club.

Our progress in improving our facilities has been the critical achievement this Season and it is important to recognize the support we enjoy from our Local councillor David Cooper (Scott Ward), Council officers; Mark Stockton, Heather O'Callaghan and Rod Lintott as well as their Teams plus local MP support from the State shadow Treasurer – Kim Wells and Federal member Chris Pearce.

The committee met every challenge head on in our endeavours to create a home away from home. The enormous amount of planning and around (\$2000) was spent plus there was a huge amount of work and hours put in by Jason Buljubasic, who has to be acknowledged as he worked himself into the ground (when he wasn't landscaping Hancock's). There was also a lot of work put in by Greg Howe's, Andrew Hawkes, Dave Thomas & Dave Hancock plus selected members of the committee and playing group to dress up the damaged, dirty & dilapidated pavilion at Llewellyn.

2 New cricket pitches (\$6000) went down and all of a sudden we were underway. New uniforms for all of the clubs 16 Teams were created (\$8000) and we looked the part. A pre-season program was partly and at times poorly supported in many grades but our New club coach, Chris Amos managed to pull together a good preparation and our playing group's hopes were high. A new club captain was appointed and we welcomed Travis Mulder back to the fold.

From a Junior perspective our Junior clinic was poorly supported on a cold and windy day at Llewellyn but after it was all said and done we still managed to have our highest number of Junior Teams for years with a good quality of team in place in most grades. New junior coaches in Joe DeVenuto (U/13 A), Lee Metherell (U/17B) and Ian Jongen (U/11) were in place and as has been the case in the past David Hancock volunteered to look after our new U/13 Black team. We also had 8 players complete their Level 1 accreditation, a \$1000 expenditure invested in helping our club to provide the Best support possible for Junior cricket.

By end of November we had 4 Junior Teams travelling well, 4 Senior sides promising Finals action and 2 veteran's teams also travelling well. We also had our New net complex up and running, thus giving our club the most modern and safest training facility in the Competition...... an investment of \$35,000 in club funds (+ a council grant) in securing the clubs future. We received a \$10,000





grant from the City of Knox but our promised \$25,000 from Local Federal MP Chris Pearce did not eventuate when a Labor government was elected.

Pre Xmas we successfully ran our \$2500 Cash draw and achieved a great result with once again a disappointing attendance. Talking poor attendance we also celebrated the remarkable career of a club legend with the retirement of Rhys Marget but were embarrassed to only have 50 people turn up. The sportsman's Night was also a great financial success but again poorly supported.

As always our Christmas cocktail party function ran with reasonable support and a good night was had by all.

January saw a strong Knox Gardens contingent active in Rep Teams. We had Jayden Hawkes and Josh Wylde play in the successful FTGDCA Mitchell Cup (U/12)Team which was brilliantly managed by Andrew Hawkes, Scott McInerney played in the David Hancock coached FTGDCA Russell Allen Shield, Ash Hawkes (Malvern) and Rob Howes (Bayswater) played hatch (U/15 State Championship), Michael Hutchins FTGDCA U/16's and Wayne McInerney (Outer East U/18's). At a senior Level Adam Wild was chosen for the FTGDCA to play in country week where he accounted for himself with great success.

Following the Xmas break the wheels fell off some of our senior sides and much of our Preseason optimism was shattered when our 1st and 4th X1's lost some games that perhaps they needed to win.

Our U/15's coached by Dane and our U/13A sides continued on their winning ways to set up dates with destiny. Our 2 Vets sides continued their winning ways to both make Finals.

At the business end of the Season, we saw 2 Junior sides, 2 Senior sides and 2 Vets sides make Semi Final appearances. This then eventuated in 4 Grand finals appearances but for the 1^{st} time in many years The Knox Gardens CC trophy cabinet had no new editions.

It should be said that to make Finals is an achievement in itself. To play in a GF is in many ways a Win, so it is important to acknowledge the efforts of the Coaches, Captains, players & supporters in achieving what we did.

Off the Field it has been an extremely challenging year and without the HUGE efforts of the Committee members we would not have had the stability that we had. Their efforts by were truly magnificent.

Notably, specifically and importantly I would like to **THANK**:

- We would not have the security or stability without the Accounting & Financial skills and persistence of Rob Cottle.
- The Club socially would be a lonely place and missing real passion without the tireless work of Rhys & Dave Thomas who epitomize the heart and soul of the club. Their work around the club can go unnoticed by many but is Herculean.





- On the Junior front, Andrew Hawkes gives of himself like no other. His Friday night and early Saturday morning starts to setup, attendance with Dave Thomas at Association meetings, time spent organising coaches, parents & teams plus simply mucking in with club activities needs to be recognized.
- As always David Hancock has over extended himself to run a Girls program, our Milo program, coached the FTGDCA U/14 rep team and also coached the U/11's & U/13's.
- Ben McLean who created our Sensational Falcons website and managed the clubs Senior player data & registration plus also helped significantly with the club's administration.
- Greg Howes & family who contributed significantly to our club functions and also in helping to run the juniors.
- As mentioned earlier the work that Jason put in on the Llewellyn setup, clubroom improvements, ground improvements and the Net project was significant and greatly appreciated.
- To the Captains and coaches of all Teams I thank you for the time that you have given up and for the sacrifices made. I also want to thank your partners and families for accepting the impacts of your efforts.
- I'd also like to thank the ladies, Helen & Anne who regularly pitched in and helped with our Fundraising activities.
- Finally I'd like to recognize the efforts of Club coach Chris Amos, who in his 1st year at the club has worked tirelessly to bring a programmed set of activities and create an opportunity for all players to improve. He has ably been assisted by Ray Philips as Chairman of selectors who has become a very important cog in our Future success. I'd like to thank Kaye & Mandy their very understanding wives who as always supported the guy's investment in time for our playing group.

The club has some challenges ahead most notably shaking off the perception that it is difficult to regularly attract large interest in club activities both within the Junior and Senior club.

This Season we have battled the impact of not having our main ground available, we have not had the crowds we would hope for at functions, we have had to cope with losing **over \$3000** in Theft after break-ins at both our clubrooms and Llewellyn. We have invested **over \$50,000** in "one off "expenses such as the New Training facility, cricket pitches, coaching accreditation, uniforms, and Pavilion improvements. We have also suffered significantly from reduced bar takings and canteen due to being located at Llewellyn.

Having started the Season with a Bank balance of \$22,000 we have managed our funds well to end with a bank balance in the vicinity of \$5,000 by seasons end. Given our "one off" expenses and the significant impact of being at Llewellyn, this is a sensational result, giving the club improved facilities, a New main ground and New pitch, plus now 3 other grounds all with new wickets to support our future growth and a solid base for our future.

The club is now set to enter a New Season well equipped to focus on returning to our Winning ways and to have an agreed controlled focus on moving our 1st X1 to be a Premiership side in Decoite shield and have even greater success for the future.





I would like to challenge our players young and old to understand what has been provided for you through the efforts of the loyal band of Knox Gardens members who support the vision of our club being a powerhouse in the Local competition.

With undisputedly the BEST ground and facilities in the Eastern suburbs it is time to deliver in 08/09 and nothing short of 5 flags from our Seniors & Juniors plus Veterans flag would be an acceptable result.

I would also challenge our Senior players to get involved in recruiting and also ask that our football contingent network their mates to help drive our Senior team numbers to 6 next season (4 in 2 day grades & 2 in 1 day grades). From a Junior perspective I hope that we can field 6 Saturday Teams in U/13, U/15 & U/17 and maintain our 3 U/11's and potentially have a girls U/11 team or U/13 Team next year. Looking at our Vets group I would hope that we can have 2 sides again in 08/09.

The club also needs more Junior coaches and over winter I would ask some of our senior players to complete their Level 1 accreditation and start to get involved.

The decision to achieve this and much much more rests with you and I would ask that we challenge our culture, increase our support and work ethic to be a **Club of Commitment** in what will be a Milestone year.

Congratulations to all trophy winners and Team of the Year awardees for your contribution to club success.

The current season has been difficult financially with the Club trading at Llewellyn and Knox Gardens Reserve. This has resulted in lower bar/canteen turnover.

The Club has upgraded the practice facilities at a cost of \$35,000 financed by \$20,000 from prior bank balances, \$10,000 council grants and the balance from 2008 trading year.

In addition 2007/2008 saw new player shirts provided for the whole Club, at a cost of \$7,000. Sponsorship levels are similar to the prior year, the Club is grateful for their generous support.

At the completion of the season there will be a small bank surplus, with the best facilities in the competition, however greater support from members will be required to enjoy the hard work undertaken this year.

2007 / 08 Junior Coordinators Report

So, second year in the role and it didn't get any easier. A change in Club President saw a hard drive to improve facilities and opportunities around the club and didn't allow much rest for the committee.... The main Knox Gardens ground was unavailable for the season which saw Llewellyn Reserve play a major part in our fixturing this season. We kicked off again with a Junior Clinic, and although reasonably well attended, the benefits are not being realised from this activity. A last minute addition of a third under 13 team saw us register nine Junior teams – two in under 17's, one under 15, three under 13's and three under 11's (two "hardball" and one "soft") Battling weekly for numbers, it was decided to remove the second under 17 team part way into the season.

The building of our training facility – 6 quality batting nets with a fully laid covering for bowling and fielding drills was completed soon after daylight savings kicked in, allowing for improved training sessions being conducted. This facility is the envy of all teams that saw it, and two Association Representative teams used it as a training base as well.

Our on field performances were varied, we must wish for success for our under 15 and 13 / 1 teams in their Grand Finals this weekend. The 17's struggled for consistency, while the Red and Black 13's both improved throughout the season although not threatening for finals action. The under 11 teams have all enjoyed learning the game from some senior legends – Ray Buckett, Peter Webb and Ian Jongen. The skills of all the juniors have continued to improve as the season progressed.

Knox Gardens cricket club is particularly indebted to Dave Hancock, our Junior Development guru. Not only did Dave once again run his highly successful Milo programme on a Friday night, he also conducted an eight week development programme for girls on Thursday nights in conjunction with Cricket Victoria. Having some time on his hands following this, playing on Saturday arvo's in the 4ths and every second Sunday in the Vets, Dave also took on the role as coach of the under 13 blacks and the Associations under 14 Representative team. Somehow Dave also has a life outside of cricket, regularly wooing his wife onto the dance floor for a Tuesday night foxtrot, and managed to marry off one of his offspring during cricket season. Dave, I am in awe of your energy and passion and hope everyone who reads this appreciates what you do and thanks you for your dedication to improving the Knox Gardens junior cricketers.

This season saw an increased presence in Representative cricket with myself managing the FTGDCA Mitchell Shield (under 12) team and Dave Hancock and Ray McInerney coaching and managing the FTGDCA Russell Allen (under 14) team. I should also mention that Bill Leane once again coached the Broadmeadows Hatch (under 15) team to the final of their competition with his boys somehow snatching defeat from the jaws of victory. But it's not about us as coaches, it's about the boys who play at this higher level. Congratulations to Wayne McInerney (17's when District commitments allow) playing for Outer East Eagles in the under 18 carnival, Michael Hutchins (17's) who represented FTGDCA in the under 16 carnival, Rob Howes (15's) playing for Bayswater and Ash Hawkes (15's) playing for Malvern, both in the Sub District RM Hatch carnival. From the under 13's, Scott McInerney represented the FTGDCA in the Russell Allen Shield (u/14) Jayden Hawkes and Josh Wylde in the Mitchell Shield (u/12) and Mitchell Tsirtsikos in the Josh Brown Plate (also u/12) Additional congratulations to Jayden, Josh and myself for winning the





Mitchell Cup – the first FTGDCA team to do so. I should also add that at the time of going to print, Mitchell T has progressed to stage two in the selection process for the Primary Schools State team, for the national carnival to be held in Darwin in June.

Once again my major disappointment for the season was the lack of junior parent support at club functions. Not just the clubs major functions, but also the regular awards nights and even the Christmas breakup. As was said in last years report, and mentioned several times during the current season, running a club of our size and providing facilities that are the envy of all other clubs, is a costly exercise. Unfortunately it appears necessary to increase our fees for next season. Please consider that we will have the best ground, function room and training facility in the area and work with us to provide a social environment for our club to prosper in.

We have been faced with some tough times this season that most of you would not be aware of, but we are committed to providing the best possible opportunities for our junior cricketers to develop whilst enjoying being with their mates. So going forwards, we expect to maintain our current numbers for the 2008 / 09 season and continue to provide a pathway for improvement for all our players.

Senior Coaches Report

My first season as coach of the Knox Gardens Falcons has come to a close and the roller coaster ride has come to an end.

Firstly to all those in the captains Travis, Jason, Rhys, Mark and Simon thank you for your support during the 2007/08 season as well as Ray Borg for his help on Tuesday and Thursday nights.

The year began with pre season at Maddocks in late August and whilst we had a steady turnout over the following weeks, consistency in player attendance became an issue. As we all know, having a committed pre season is a vital step in any tilt at end of season glory. We had a varied program this year from the themed net session to pool and boxing workouts.

Our final pre season hit outs came in the form of practice matches against Bentleigh (Sub District), Ringwood (District) and Knoxfield (FTGDA), and gave us all a good idea of where we were at as far as preparation and also what we could expect in the coming rounds.

The Season began with a bang in round 1 with 4 wins and so it come crashing down to earth in round 2 with only 2. This mixed form continued on to Xmas with 27/10/08 being of note as the only week end that all 5 sides came home with a win. The 5ths did have a forfeit on that day, however still technically a clean sweep. Unfortunately the only one for the year.

So at Xmas we had the 1st in touch with the top four, 2nds still in with a chance of making finals, 3rds eyeing of a top spot, 4ths well in entrenched in the 4 and the 5ths unbeatable. We resumed training again in early Jan, hoping for success, only to stumble in the early rounds to slowly slip out of contention in the all grades except the 3rds and 5ths. Next season will be much improved with access to the top ground with a near perfect grass surface and the pavilion available for shade, access to canteen and facilities.

1st XI

2008 year got off to a strong start when we played Eildon Park away in round. (One day match) After winning the toss, we made 7/156 off 40 overs with J.MACKINNON top scoring with 48. Eildon Park were all out for 56, J.THORPE having a day out with 3/10. Easy win.

The following week was away again at Aura Vale. With our stocks depleted, Aura Vale scrambled 212 runs from their 80 overs. Newcomer I.JONGEN bowled tirelessly for 4/48. Our run chase began and ended abruptly, all out for 104. Poor batting performance.

Round 3 at Johnson Park was to be Rhys MARGETS final first XI match following a magnificent career. The Parkers won the toss and batted, all out for 128. A. WILD bagging his first 5 wicket haul of many for the season. The Falcons made the runs comfortably with T. MULDER 49* and R. MARGET 25 and 3/30 in Johnson Parks 2nd dig. A good win.

Our first home match vs Knox on the bottom ground again proved to be fruitful. S. HETTIARACHIAGE took us off with a flying 71. Our tail wagged and we ended up all out for 202. We then skittled Knox for 91 - T. MULDER 4/25, then sent Knox back in. We narrowly missed outright points, rolling Knox again for 120. J. BUTCHER 5/37.

Round 5 vs Lysterfield was the catalyst for a string of poor batting performances for our side. We won the toss and batted – all out 117 with J.CONDON 53 and J.PHILLIPS 35 scoring the bulk of our runs. The Beavers cruised to victory with 277 - A. WILD 5/70.

Home to Ferntree Gully ended up a wash out. FTG all out 194 – J. THORPE 3/29 and A. WILD 3/46. Knox Gardens 2/34.

Round 8 vs in form side Footballers was another dismal batting performance – We won the toss and were all out for 73 off 28 overs. Footballers passed us 9/147 dec, (A. WILD 3/45 & M. YOUNG 2/17) and beat us outright when they yet again rolled us for 75.

Round 7 (one day game vs Upwey) was rescheduled for the following day and we put on a reasonable total of 150 from 45 overs J.PHILLIPS 30. Unfortunately the ball didn't hold up during the wet afternoon, and Upwey made the runs off 39 overs. J. THORPE took early wickets with 3/29.

Round 9 at home vs South Belgrave was a "make or break" game for us, and after a slow start we reeled in their batsmen for 180. (T.MULDER 5/31 & A. WILD 4/45) Once again our batting lacked substance – all out for 96 (J. PHILLIPS 30) We batted again and got our noses in front 5/156 dec. before the South BELGRAVE bats got over the line for an outright win to them.

Away vs the Basin we started reasonably by putting 187 runs on the board (T. MULDER 46. J. BUTCHER 45) but was dominated by A. WILD with the ball taking 6/40 and knocking over the Basin for 116. During our 2nd innings we saw our little master S. HETTIARACHIAGE smash 100* and notably supported by S. TAYLOR 34*.

The final match at home vs Knoxfield saw Adam WILD taking off where he left off from the previous match, blasting them out for 79 with figures of 6/32. We then achieved a record score performance thanks to late inclusion Aaron BAILEY with 72 and a magnificent unbeaten century to Josh GREGORY with 110*. Surprisingly to the rest of his team mates (but not to him) J. THORPE belted 63 at the end of the innings. All in all a good finish to the year, however not without the disappointment of having no bearing in the finals.



This shows the improvement that was made by each player throughout the season and they can all be very proud of their achievements.

Even though it was a great team effort all year I must mention some individual efforts for the season. Scotty McInerney led by example with both bat and ball. He had an outstanding season, in particular his batting, as he amassed an incredible 431 runs @ 143.67, with a highest score of 74*. Dylan Wylde also had a great year with bat and ball, scoring 353 runs @ 58.83, with a highest score of 96*. Jayden Hawkes showed a marked improvement with both bat and ball and finished the season with a couple of retirements with the bat and 17 wickets @ 11.47, with a best performance of 4/9.

We had 4 association representative players over Christmas including Scotty McInerney U14's Hatch, Jayden Hawkes and Josh Wylde U12's Mitchell Shield which won the Mitchell Cup, and Mitchell Tsirtsikos U12's Josh Browne Plate. With eleven players we could have tried to learn to play more shots to have retired batsmen batting at the end of the innings again. Tactics would have become more relevant to the team members.

Our team comprised many under age children so I expect they will all benefit from this season and be better cricketer's next year when they will play teams in their proper age bracket. A winter of growth and maturity makes a huge difference.

I let the team down by not arriving to training sessions and many game days in a timely manner. I over extended myself with too many roles at the Club. The biggest was taking on coaching the FTGDCA u14 representative team. Anthony Davies was invited to play in the last game against Yarra Valley because his pace bowling in the last 2 rounds was very impressive and I had a few regular players unavailable. As it turned out the game was forfeited by Yarra Valley and Anthony played with Scott McInerney in a trial game. Both players acquitted themselves very well.

All players have skills to develop. I hope they all enjoyed their season with me. My "Coaches Award" goes to Grace Mills. She showed courage whilst batting, protecting the stumps and bowled very well. Her catching was extremely solid and she always listened to my instructions. Our team welcomed her with enthusiasm. Grace with her brother helped our team to become more competitive.

I enjoyed coaching this team and watching each member grow over the season. Good luck for next season! Special thanks to Nirmal DeSilva for scoring most of the season and helping out on the ground.
